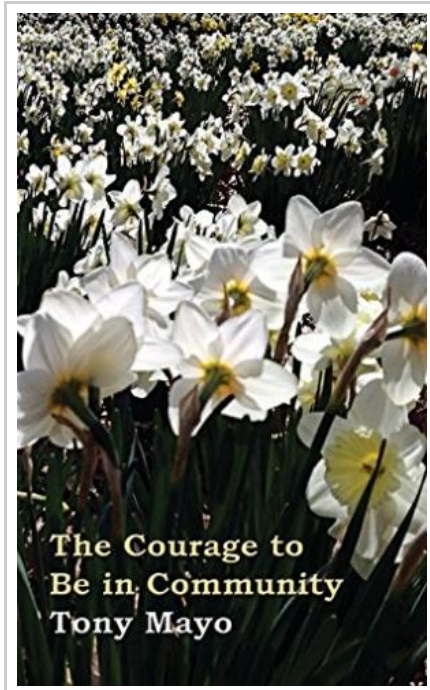




The Courage to Be in Community: A Call for Compassion, Vulnerability, and Authenticity (Hardback)
