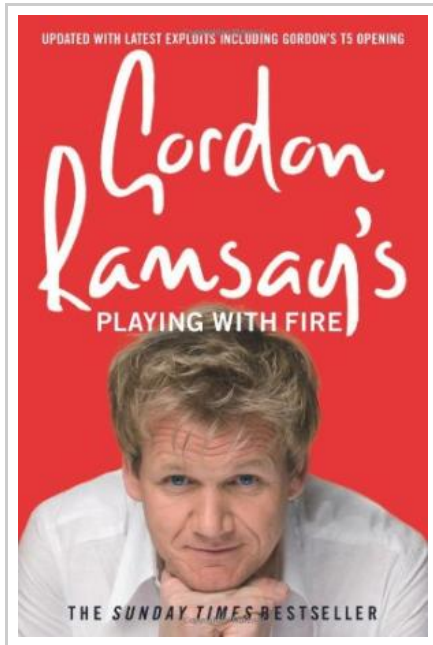




Gordon Ramsay's Playing with Fire
