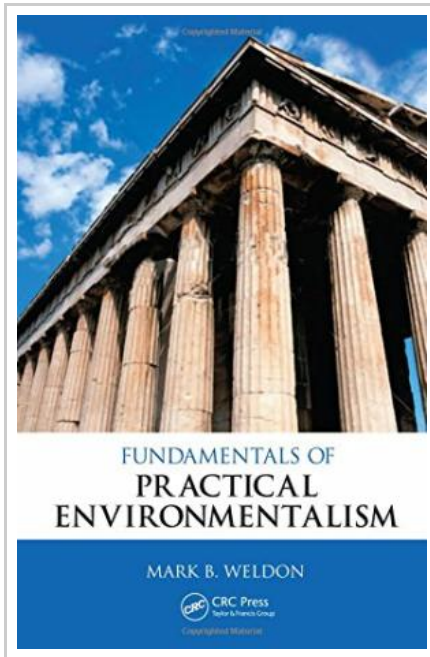




Fundamentals of Practical Environmentalism
