The transitional sections of the book (ReSet, Set and Lect) intertwine in theme and expression, though individually ranging in tone and voice. Reset revives the most common clichs of Canadian lyricism--nature and maple syrup, landscape, Icarus falling, human-rights rhetoric, war, ancestral migration, death, love, disease--to simultaneously validate and critique the experiential urgency of such themes. Set engages with the struggle of the individual against political and economic powers, through a vernacular voice, bringing forth the lack of agency as They signed Yu Darvish without seeing his fork. They signed their books without looking up at us. They gave you fries with that without even asking. The final section--Lect--simulates grad-school jargon, plumbing terminology, and the directives of GPS in order to explore the limitations of esoteric linguistic ontologies: Stay left on Ethics. Flow one-way street towards inertia. Stay left. Signal interrupted. Wingers explorations of semi-private languages move...
