Broken Chains is an adventure for 6th-level characters, written for the Pathfinder Roleplaying Game and compatible with the 3.5 edition of the world s oldest RPG. In addition to the adventure, this volume also features a brand-new monster and a fully detailed slave auction (suitable for destruction) that can be used in any fantasy campaign.
