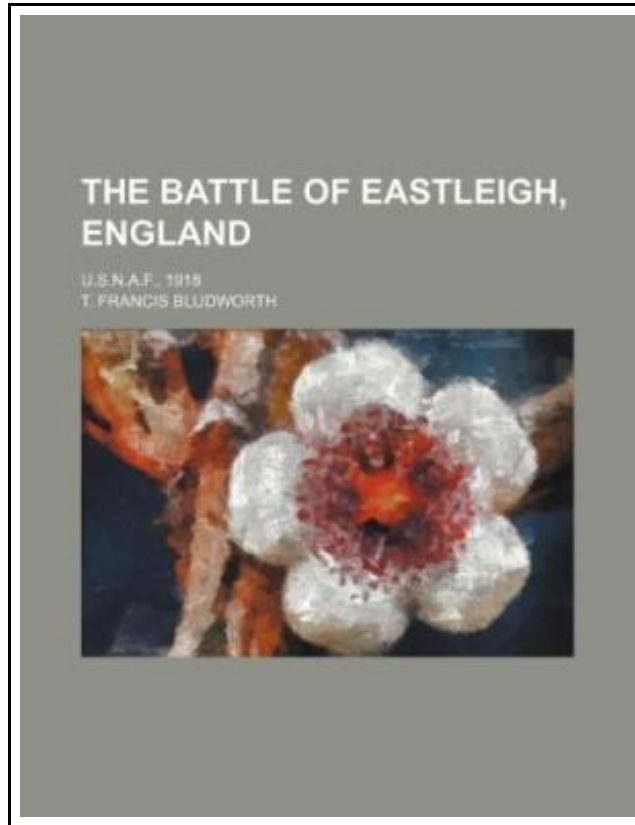


The Battle of Eastleigh, England U.S.N.A.F., 1918



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
